Nursing services available

We offer acute and chronic nursing care, as well as ongoing monitoring and support including:

- Hospital in the home care
- Post-acute care
- Managing complex acute and chronic wounds
- Medication management and supervision
- · Administering intravenous medication
- Continence management and catheter care
- Diabetes management
- Infusion therapy
- Assistance with daily living requirements including application of compression stockings, medication prompting and general wellbeing checks

Assessments

We offer comprehensive, holistic and clinical nursing assessments for you in your own home, and can provide recommendations and care plans for safe ongoing support or for the prevention of failing health. These assessments can include cognition screening, support for continence issues, falls and safety, medication management, diabetes management and wound care support.
